Interview several non- management staff. Interview several mid- level managers. Review notes and summarize findings.
Debrief with CIO	 Interview additional personnel to clarify key issues.
	• Meet with CIO to debrief and to present preliminary findings. Discuss most severe issues and the 3-4 recommendations that would have a positive impact on the organization.
